

The Cost of (Ethical) Breeding

Keep in mind that breeding (when done right) is not a profitable venture. Good breeders work mainly in the interest of **bettering the breed**. Let's take the Dalmatian, for example.

The following estimates are low-end and only account for basic treatments. It's very common that extra help (and extra cost) is required before, during, and after pregnancies.

Don't breed until both parents are **minimum** two years old.

Recommended Tests for Breeding per parent (Dalmatian-specific)

If ANY test results are poor, the dogs **should** not be bred.

This is the estimated cost before the dogs are even ready to breed!

Emergency C-Sections are more common in certain breeds. However, all breeders should have the ability to fund this lifesaving surgery if needed.
